The Southern part of the Inca civilization once ruled where our estate vineyards are now located in Cafayate, Salta, Argentina, at over 6,000 feet above sea level. Just as the Incas wove their intricate histories into the quipu, so our winemaker Luis Asmet has crafted a stunning, complex wine that exemplifies the terroir of Salta. This blend of 50% Malbec, 30% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Tannat, and 10% Syrah combines the rich fruit and violet flavors of the Malbec, the depth of the Cabernet Sauvignon, the intense body of the Tannat, and the spice and leather aromas of the Syrah.
