

CAMINO DEL INCA MALBEC

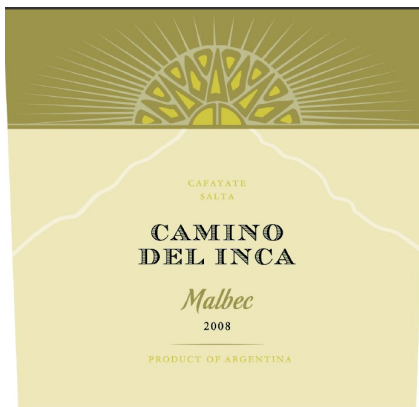
Description: We strive for a Cafayate, Salta *terroir*-driven Malbec that is easy-to-drink with aromas of bright red fruits, blackberries, and earth.
