

CAMINO DEL INCA TORRONTÉS

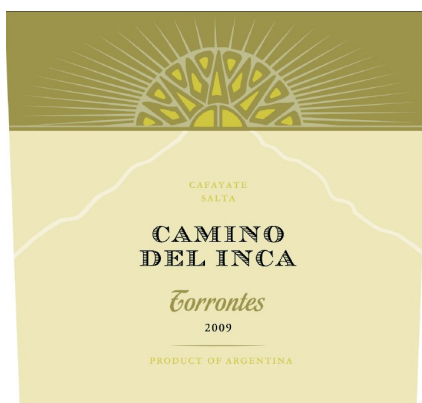
