

LAMADRID MALBEC ROSÉ

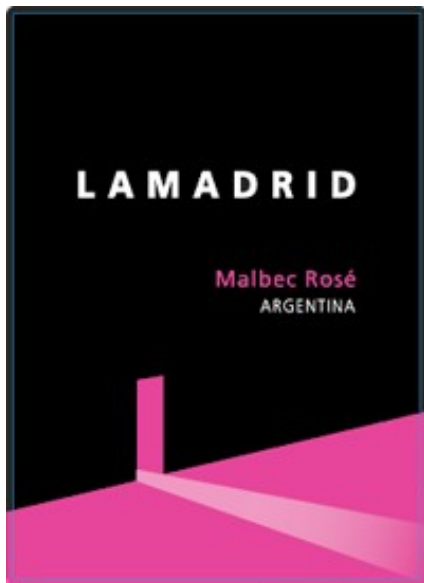
Description: We strive for an Agrelo *terroir*-driven Malbec Rosé that is easy-to-drink and fun, with intensive fruit character and aromas of cherries, strawberries, wild raspberries and herbs. 50% dropped fruit and 50% *saignée*.

Label Notes: Lamadrid is the name of the family of the owner and founder, Guillermo García Lamadrid. In each bottle of Lamadrid we open a door and discover a world of unique experiences and sensations.
