Criss Cross Chardonnay

97% Chardonnay, 2% Gewurtztraminer, 1% Muscat. Lodi.

88 points, Wine Enthusiast ('15).

Lush, complex flavors with richness coming from partial malolactic fermentation in oak.

Criss Cross Cabernet Sauvignon

98% Cabernet Sauvignon, 1.5% Petite Sirah, 0.5% blend of Merlot, Malbec, Petit Verdot, and Teroldego. Clarksburg.

Classic Cab with ripe black cherry aromas followed by blueberry, spice, cocoa, and hits of toffee. 6 months in French oak.

Criss Cross Petite Sirah

90.4% Petite Sirah, 9.6% Syrah. Lodi and Clarksburg.

Excellent density and richness, with the black fruit staying bold and upfront on the palate.

Criss Cross Old Vine Zinfandel

81% Zinfandel; 19% Petite Sirah. 10 months in French oak. 100% estate Lodi vineyards, average age 80 years.
