Altocedro

The Año Cero Malbec '08 received 91 points from Wine & Spirits; the Año Cero Tempranillo '09 received 90 points and the Altocedro Gran Reserva 93 points from Wine Advocate; the Altocedro Reserva '06 92 points from Wine Spectator and was in its “Top 100 Wines of 2008”



Camino del Inca

The high desert terroir of Salta is a unique Argentine grape-growing region, and we believe Camino del Inca is the best representative of this exciting place. Winemakers are Paul Hobbs and Luis Asmet.

Wilfred Wong awarded the '07 Camino del Inca Quipu Blend 93 points. The Torrontés '10 received 90 points from Robert Parker's Wine Advocate.



Ksana

Concentrated and complex wines from Las Compuertas; only indigenous yeasts; no filtering; and the malolactic fermentation occurs in oak. Pablo Durigutti, winemaker.

The Ksana Bonarda '07 received 88 points and the Ksana Malbec Reserva '06 92 points from Wine Spectator; Wine Advocate gave the Gran Reserva '06 93 points.



Lamadrid

“Great Value Winery to Look For” -Robert Parker. Ancient Agrelo vineyards, by Héctor Durigutti.

The classic '09 reds all received 90 points and the Reservas '08 91 points from Wine Advocate, who also gave the Malbec Gran Reserva '06 94 points. The Malbec '08 and Cabernet Sauvignon '08 both received “Best Buys” from Wine Enthusiast.



Manos Negras

Latitude winemaking from exciting terroirs of Argentina and Chile.

Stunning Malbec from Altamira ('07 90 pts WA); Pinot Noir from Neuquén, Patagonia ('08 90 pts WA); Torrontés from San Juan ('09 90 pts WA); and coming soon from Chile a Carmenere from Colchagua, a Cabernet Sauvignon from Alto Maipo and a Sauvignon Blanc from Casablanca.



Tapiz

Winemaker Fabian Valenzuela and vineyard manager Carlos Correas create a “tapestry” between high-altitude concentrated fruit and judicious use of oak barrels.

Tapiz Reserva Selección de Barricas received 94 points from Cuisine & Vins and the Tapiz Malbec '08 89 points from Wine Spectator. The Torrontés '09 won the Argentine Wine Awards Trophy. Tapiz Malbec Black Tears scored 97 points from Wilfred Wong.



Verum

“True” Patagonia. Verum is a top example of the awesome winemaking potential of Rio Negro, Patagonia. The winemakers are Alberto Antonini and Marcelo Vignoni.

The Verum Chardonnay received 90 points from The Wine Advocate and Wilfred Wong gave 90 points to the Verum Pinot Noir.



Zolo

Argentina's top value brand: so good for the money they will “blow your hat off.” Produced at one of Argentina's most technologically advanced wineries, with estate vineyards located throughout Mendoza.

The Zolo Torrontés '10 was named “Best Buy” by Wine Enthusiast; the Zolo Malbec '08 received 91 pts and the Cab. Sauv. Reserva '07 90 pts from Robert Parker's Wine Advocate.



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
