About Tapiz Alta Collection: To celebrate the addition of Jean Claude Berrouet (ex-Petrus) as Consultant Winemaker, Tapiz released a new "Alta Collection" line of wines in 2013. The *alta* (high-altitude) fruit comes from Tapiz's sustainably-farmed estate vineyards in Uco Valley, Mendoza. Chief Winemaker Fabian Valenzuela and Jean Claude work together to create a beautiful *tapiz* (tapestry) between the wine's intense fruit and its oak aging.

Fermentation and Maceration: A cold pre-maceration takes place at 8°C for 5 days to extract color and aromas. Fermented in stainless steel tanks for approximately 14 days at 28°C then rests on the lees for 16 days.

Malolactic Fermentation: 100% Spontaneous

Aging: 10 months in French (90%) and American (10%) oak barrels (first and second use)

Alcohol: 13.9

Residual Sugar: 3.62 g/L

Acidity: pH of 3.65; TA of 5.50 g/L
