

TAPIZ MALBEC BLACK TEARS

Description: We strive for a very concentrated and complex Malbec representing the best of its San Pablo, Valle de Uco *terroir*.

Label Notes: Tapiz is Spanish for "tapestry," as in the tapestry between the wine's high-altitude fruit and oak. The wine is called Black Tears because of the amazing color intensity.

Aging: 24 months in new French oak barrels.

Alcohol: 14.5

Residual Sugar: 2.9 g/L

Acidity: pH of 3.65; TA of 6.0 g/L
