Description: We strive for an elegant and expressive Pinot Noir (coming from our prized high-altitude San Pablo vineyard) with aromas of cherries, flowers, and touches of minerality and vanilla.

Label Notes: Tapiz is Spanish for "tapestry"; the label and capsule display the different components combined to create the wine, such as its high-altitude fruit, the land, the sun, and the workers.

Aging: 8 months in French oak barrels

Alcohol: 14.0

Residual Sugar: 2.05 g/L

Acidity: pH of 3.64; TA of 5.70 g/L
